#### **Ironport Spam Quarantine**

To access our Ironport Spam Quarantine, go to <u>https://spam.tscpl.org:83</u> and enter your windows username and password.



### **Configuring Safelist / Blocklist**

In the top right-hand corner, click Options > Safelist or Options > Blocklist



#### Blocklist

You can add individual senders to the blocklist, or even an entire domain Simply enter the name in the space provided, and click **Add to List**

Similarly, you can explicitly trust certain users or sites altogether from the Safelist menu
